Welcome to Call of Grace Ministries. This is our first newsletter, so we thought we would briefly inform you of what we do, how the Lord has used us so far this year.

Call of Grace Ministries exists to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Preaching is part of our ministry and it is always a blessing to expound God's word to His people. However, most of our service to the Lord is on the street sharing the truth of God's mercy that was displayed with love on the cross. Mercy made available to us through the death, burial, and resurrection of the Lord Jesus when we, by faith, receive Him as Lord and Savior. We share the Good News of Jesus through personal encounters and by giving away Gospel tracts.

We also equip others who desire to do the same by providing training in personal evangelism. The focus of this training is sharing the Gospel "as you go / wherever you are". Why? Because life itself is an event and the Lord has commanded that we, "always be prepared to give an answer for the hope that is in you" (1 Peter 3:15). In addition, we also invite others to join us on the streets in various venues, providing them an opportunity to share in the blessing of telling others about what Jesus has done.

So far this year, the Lord allowed us to serve Him in the following ways and places:

Locally

- Neighborhood evangelism
- Personal evangelism training
- Sharing Jesus on the streets at "Jackyl in Concert" at Black Diamond Harley-Davidson
- Lighthouse Homeless Shelter - Bible Study and building renovation projects
- Preaching in an area church
- Multiple parades and festivals

Away from home, many times with other evangelists, we shared Jesus at:

- New Orleans, LA - Mardi Gras
- Memphis, TN - Memphis in May
- Indianapolis, IN - Memorial Day Celebration during the day and the Indy 500 crowd at night
- Hot Springs, AR - Street outreach

Working with others this year, over 78,000 gospel tracts have been distributed so far. As well, many personal witnessing encounters have occurred, with some professing Jesus as Lord. Please pray for the follow-up of those who made professions and for the seeds that have been sown.

As we continue to move forward at the Lord's call, we ask that you pray for this ministry, those who are involved, and those the Lord brings into our path.
