During the conference, our days (and evenings) were spent in worship, the Word, and witnessing opportunities on the streets of Gatlinburg. Brothers John Swaim and Roger Helton led worship. On the streets, approximately 10,000 Gospel tracts were handed out to the crowd. There were a number of witnessing conversations as well. While we were in Gatlinburg, David and his wife Sue graciously opened their home to Cindy and I. Thank you so much for allowing us into your home! The Lord used you to provide for our needs and we are truly grateful.

The remainder of July, we have been involved in local missions. We are on mission for the Lord locally throughout the year. However, during this time of year we place a special importance on it as there are many fairs, local festivals, and other events that occur this time of year. This emphasis on local outreach will continue through August.


