"He who calls you is faithful; he will surely do it." 1 Thessalonians 5:24 (ESV)

The faithfulness of God! Isn't it a wondrous thing? In his benediction to the Thessalonians, Paul prays for them to be "preserved blameless" until the coming of Christ. He continues immediately with the verse above, reminding the Thessalonians that their blamelessness does not rely on them: it is a result of the faithfulness of God! And just as I am sure that this statement brought peace and joy to the Thessalonians, it should to all Believers.

Faithful. The word may be defined as showing constant loyalty or being true to what you have said. Scripture reveals that throughout time our Lord has shown Himself to be just that! From the moment He said, "Let there be light", until the time He said, "It is finished", the Lord displayed His faithfulness in a myriad of ways. In the process of revealing His Faithfulness, He also revealed His Power to accomplish His Purpose. A purpose that included your restoration to Him because the purpose of the Cross does not stand alone, it is accompanied by the power revealed in the Lord's Resurrection! The power of God to defeat sin and death! The power of God to create anew the hearts of all who will receive Him by faith! The power of God that allows us to live a life that glorifies Him because of "the immeasurable greatness of His power toward us who believe"!

Revealed both in His Word and in Power through the death and resurrection of Jesus, God's faithfulness may be seen. And His faithfulness is unchanging because it is part of His nature. This is what Paul was telling the Thessalonians. This is what this passage reveals to us today. That because God is faithful, He will, in His power, preserve us blameless, able to stand before Him when He comes again! As one man put it, *"It is profoundly satisfying to the Believer to know that, in the last resort, what matters is not his feeble hold on God, but God's strong grip on him."*

Thank you for your prayers! In the past months we asked that you pray for additional opportunities to bring God's Word to His people. We had also requested that you pray for the Bible study the Lord had given us the desire to start at the 4Cs shelter. Both of these requests were granted by the Lord! We have been called to bring God's Word multiple times to multiple places. In the process, we have met some wonderful people who love the Lord. 
Prayer requests for our ministry
