As the conversation above continued, the Holy Spirit convicted John of His need for Jesus as the Lord of his life. John is one of 23 people the Lord saved during those few days in July on the streets of Cairo. Please be in prayer for the seeds that were sown, your new Brothers and Sisters, and the follow-up that is ongoing.

The Great Eclipse of 2017 has come and gone. Cindy and I took time that weekend to share the truth of the Gospel with people in our area. Jason Bond, Jeff Fauver, and Cale Fauver joined us to pass Gospel tracts and engage people in Gospel conversations. The crowds were lighter than expected in our area over the weekend. 
