Both of these couples also participate in the fellowship of Christ on the mission field with all who come together for one reason: to share the Gospel message. I pray each one of these who take part in this ministry realize the blessing they are to others to the glory of the Lord!

When I returned from Kansas, Cindy and I headed for Hillman Ferry Campground in Kentucky. Our purpose was to act as chaplains if a need arose and to facilitate the worship service for the campers on the next Sunday morning. Music had been chosen for the service but we did not have accompaniment for it and planned to sing a cappella. However, the Lord provided three people to both lead and provide music from the campers who were there. Our thanks to Max, Katy, and Rob who used their talents to serve the Lord that Sunday morning.




A remembrance for my grandchildren:
