The work of God: believe in Jesus. This is the message proclaimed in the Bible and this is the message that Cindy, myself, and others proclaimed while serving the Lord in Kansas with the John 3:16 Horseshoe Ministry. This ministry, facilitated by Believer's Southern Baptist Church in Wichita, seeks the privilege of sharing the Gospel with a person by offering them a free horseshoe stamped with their name. For the past several years, Cindy and I have joined in fellowship with our Kansan Brothers and Sisters to share the Gospel at the Kansas State Fair.

In the past, the time at the fair has always been one of great unity and fellowship in service; we have a common goal. This year was no different. We served our Lord as one. The days were long. At times the days were slow as people walked by us. At other times they were hectic and we could barely keep up with the influx of people who wanted that free horseshoe and needed to hear the Gospel. All the time, however, each day was filled with the sweetness and joy of the Lord that is only truly found when service to the Lord is offered in worship of Him!

And during those days we stood in awe of what God did: praising Him for His faithfulness! During the fair, over 2,800 people received a horseshoe. This means that **over 2,800 people of all ages heard the Gospel message!** This was done in small groups or one-on-one. As the Gospel was shared, **360 people confessed Jesus as their Lord and Savior** as they were convicted by the Holy spirit of their need! As well, **64 Christians rededicated their lives to the Lord** as they were convicted of their need for a refreshed walk with Jesus!

Churches are now in the process of following up with these people who made decisions for the Lord. Please be in prayer for the people groups above. Pray also for the churches who have embraced the privilege of the responsibility we have as Believers to come alongside our Brothers and Sisters and, in love, help them along the narrow path.

Finally, pray for those who heard the truth and walked away. The seed has been planted. Pray that the Lord will orchestrate their path in such a way that they will choose to respond to Him in true faith. For if they do, the Lord will certainly receive them! ***"for, "Everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved."*** (Romans 10:13)

Brothers and Sisters, this ministry is unique and has proven to be fruitful; throughout the years, the Lord has blessed this ministry and shown it to be one that He will honor by reaping a harvest of souls. Lord willing, Cindy and I will bring this type of ministry to our area for a couple of small venues next year. To do this, we need three things. First, we need your prayers. Cindy and I will be seeking the Lord's wisdom regarding everything from the proper venues to the least item required to do this ministry. We know the Lord will provide this (James 1:5). We ask that you pray for us that we will "have ears to hear and eyes to see" what the Lord shows us as we move forward.

Second, we cannot do this alone. We will need people to come alongside in service to the Lord. This ministry requires a number of people to perform the various tasks that must be done in addition to sharing the Gospel. Would you be willing to serve with us for a day or two? Please pray about your involvement. Then if you are willing to serve in this ministry, assuming it fits your schedule at the time, please let us know.

Finally, we will need your support to help fund this effort. This ministry requires more funding than most of our efforts due to the cost of the supplies and materials that are either given away or needed to perform the ministry. We trust the Lord to provide for this. And He provides through you! If you would be willing to help financially support this effort, please send a tax deductible donation to us at the address at the top of this newsletter. Designate it to "Horseshoes", so that we will know to set the funds aside to be used for costs associated with doing this specific mission. If more funding is received than is required to perform this ministry, the additional amounts may be used to fund other aspects of our ministry.
