It was a testimony of hopelessness followed by a desperate plea to the Lord for mercy as she read then responded to the Gospel message of hope in the tract shown. And, as always, *the Lord was faithful to fulfill His word and accomplish what He had purposed!*



Jesus Loves You

I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore I will continue my faithfulness to you.

Before time began God, the Sovereign Creator of all that is or will ever be, knew that you would exist and He would love you. And when, in God's Purpose and Plan, the time came for you to exist, He created you in His image: unique among His creations.

We have remained in touch. It is wonderful to hear how the Lord is turning her life around! She is in church and praising the Lord for what He has done! In the midst of our conversations she asked me to send her some Gospel tracts, "so I can share this message with others".

Gospel tracts have been used to share the Good News since the 14th century. They were used throughout the Reformation and continue to be distributed to this day. John Wycliffe, Charles Spurgeon, and Billy Graham, among others, have written Gospel tracts as an aid for Believers to share the Gospel of our Lord with other people. Call of Grace has written some as well, including the one displayed on this page. And we pass these tracts out wherever we go. Why? Because they contain God's message of a mercy that triumphs over God's judgment on sin. A mercy made available through God's magnificent grace to all who will turn from their sin to Jesus.

How do you share the Gospel with tracts? You can distribute them at events, leave them with a tip, mail them with a card, send them with a payment (if you still send payments), give them to the people working the drive-thru for your food or coffee. . .you get the idea; the ways to distribute tracts are many and varied. You can view some of the ones we have written on our website. If you would like to have some for distribution, please contact Cindy or myself.

Mardi Gras has come and gone;. This is by far the most spiritually demanding outreach that we are involved with on an annual basis. I want to thank Joe Toy (Open Air Ministries - Philadelphia) and Mark Yoho (Fourth Watch Ministry) for their involvement in and help with this outreach, which is a team effort. This year 34 men from all walks of life came together to share the Gospel message on the streets of the French Quarter in New Orleans. An estimated 30,000 tracts were passed out! As well, the Gospel was preached to the crowds and shared one-on-one. During the time of the mission, 13 people professed their need for Jesus and turned to Him for forgiveness and salvation!

Please be in prayer for your new Brothers and Sisters in Christ as well as the seeds that were planted during this outreach.

Locally, there have been opportunities to minister at various churches from the pulpit and at the Lighthouse Shelter, where we facilitate a Bible study for the residents. Last week, a young man at the Lighthouse asked the Lord to forgive Him and take charge of His life after hearing the Gospel! Please be in prayer for this young man, the Bible study, and those who teach it. As well, we ask that you ask the Lord to provide opportunities to preach in the churches as He sees fit.

We ask for your prayers for the following opportunities to proclaim the Gospel of our Lord:

- Indy Outreach (May 23-26)
- Local events throughout May
- Crossover (June 2-9)
