"Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me. Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus."

Philippians 3:12–14 (NKJV)

Previously in this section of Philippians, the Apostle Paul has reviewed what he considered successes in his walk with God. However, he came to realize they were failures in the Lord's eyes when he met Jesus. All the things he considered as having been done for merit before the Lord were worthless with regard to the righteousness God requires. These works formerly perceived as successes Paul now calls rubbish: worthless, useless trash to be thrown away.

Whether Paul ever looked upon the memories of these actions with regret, we cannot truly know. What we can know is this; at this writing (in prison), rather than bemoaning his failures, Paul was looking to the future with anticipation and joy. His justification before the Lord was no longer his goal, it was now assured (Phil 3:9). However, Paul knew that this was a new beginning rather than an end to the journey; God had so much more in store for Him! Past failures, past successes, and circumstances are not to be dwelt upon. "What's next, Lord?"

In this new year, I pray that all of us will truly adopt this perspective which the Holy Spirit has relayed to us through Paul. Don't look back! Never stop! Continue to move forward in and with the Lord! This viewpoint is given for our encouragement. It is given for our growth in the Lord. Finally, this point of view is recorded in Scripture that we might embrace it for His Glory. And now, as in eternity, nothing else truly matters.

I ended last year and started this year in the pulpit speaking the Lord's word to two different congregations. What a blessing it is to fellowship with others and minister to them in this way! I thank you for your prayers regarding this and ask that you continue to pray the Lord will allow this as much as He sees fit.
