2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)

The world Paul knew was topsy-turvy when he wrote this letter to Timothy. It was the time of Nero. And whether it was Nero's pride, the sinful corruption found in worldly power, or that Nero was not in his right mind, it was a time of uncertainty and persecution. Imprisoned in Rome, ultimately facing execution for his faith, Paul did not allow himself to be distracted by his plight. He reached out to encourage Timothy in his faith and his mission. Paul reminded Timothy of the faith he had seen modeled in his mother and grandmother, which had been passed to him in legacy. Then he encouraged Timothy with this truth; the Lord has given us what is needed to stand in and for the faith we have received to accomplish His purpose!
