As I looked around after distributing some Gospel tracts on Bourbon St., I noticed a young man about twenty feet away. Leaning against the wall, he began to look at the tract that he had just received. I walked over to him. Saying, "Hi.", I pointed to the cross on the tract and said, "The greatest expression of God's love for you is right here; Jesus died for you." This is where my conversation with Keagan began.



Jesus Loves You

I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore I will continue my faithfulness to you.

Jeremiah 31:3 (ESV)

Before time began God, the Sovereign Creator of all that is or will ever be, knew that you would exist and He would love you. And when, in God's Purpose and Plan, the time came for you to exist, He created you in His image: unique among His creations.

Our discussion covered sin, including Keagan's, God's sure judgment upon sin, and the hopelessness and suffering of an eternity in hell that awaits those who are judged by the Lord for their sin. Then we came back to the cross. I told Keagan about Jesus: of His sinless life and His death, burial, and resurrection. After this, I told him of God's mercy, now available because Jesus died for our sins, and of the hope inherent in His resurrection. Finally we spoke of faith leading to repentance and the Lordship of Christ.

As we talked, I had watched Keagan's eyes change as he came under the Spirit's conviction. I asked him one more time if he understood what we had talked about: did it make sense to him. He said that it did. I said, "Keagan. It's not a question of whether or not you need Jesus, everyone does. The question is whether or not you will receive Him today. Will you turn to God today seeking forgiveness and, trusting what Christ did on the cross to save you, will you ask Jesus to be your Lord today?" Keagan's response? "I need to do this now." Pray for Keagan: your new Brother in Christ!

Mardi Gras was different this year. The crowd was small due to Covid restrictions. The temperature was in the forties or lower with one afternoon/early evening having a "Real Feel" temp of 18° (Brrr). The French Quarter was barricaded to restrict access during the night hours, so all our witnessing took place during the day. And, wonder of wonders, the city shut down Bourbon St. completely on Fat Tuesday: a first as far as I know!

Yet the Gospel went forth! Our team of fifteen men shared the Gospel through preaching, conversations and tract distribution. We were blessed to see the Lord at work: 8 people received Christ and one came back to the Lord! Pray for these who made decisions for Christ! Pray for the seed sown or watered toward a future harvest by the Lord! And pray also for the follow-up being done by the New Orleans Baptist Association to help assimilate and disciple those who made a decision.
