“Then the angel said to them, “Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people.”

Luke 2:10 (NKJV)

“I bring good tidings”, translates the word from which we derive evangelize or evangelism. For the people in Jesus’ day however, there was more to this word. It was not about actions and events; it was about the result. For in those days, the word was a proclamation of victory!

The history of Jesus’ time reveals this word being consistently used by messengers from the battlefield in bringing news of a victory. It was the word those behind the city-walls longed to hear because it meant the battle had been won! And it was the word God’s messengers used to proclaim to those in the struggle of sin and righteousness that the victory The LORD had decreed beforehand (Gen 3:15) had come to pass! How? ***“For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.”***

A tiny baby, wrapped in all the frailties of man (Gal 4:4), was born that night. He would grow up to be what the angels declared and the prophets had foretold: the Savior! God Himself had taken on flesh and come to earth to fight the battle for us. A battle that brought victory over sin and death, making peace with God and righteousness before Him a reality for all who will receive Jesus!

May the victory declared in the shepherd’s field that night be a part of your worship and celebration of the Savior this Christmas!
