“And he did what was right in the sight of the LORD. . .except. . .”

2 Kings, 2 Chronicles

As you read the two books of the Bible referenced above, you will find the words above, or something similar, written in the introduction of many of the kings of Judah. There are a number of things present in these textual introductions of the Kings of Judah we should notice. And, as with all of God’s word, we ought to consider how they apply to us. Today, I want to draw your attention to one of the “exceptions” that is recorded. *“And he did what was right in the sight of the Lord. . .except that the high places were not removed; the people still sacrificed and burned incense on the high places.”* (2 Kings 15:3-4).

Azariah (also referred to as Uzziah) is the king of which this particular passage is speaking. As king, his attention to his duties and responsibilities to promote peace, safety, and prosperity for the people of Judah are found in 2 Chronicles. Uzziah’s personal sacrifices/devotions were acceptable during this time, for Scripture tells us he prospered as king for as long as he sought the Lord (2 Chron. 26:5). Yet, referring to this time, the charge above is levied against him. Although his sphere of influence encompassed the nation, Uzziah did not use his position of leadership to impact his kingdom in a way that encouraged them in the proper reverence and worship of God. Even as he promoted the nation of Judah physically, Uzziah neglected the people’s greatest need, that of worshipping God alone and doing so as He proscribes!

“How does this apply to me? I’m not a king.”, you say. That’s true. However, if you know Christ, you are a child of the King (John 1:12). As such, you are an ambassador for Him in this world. And you have been given the great task of reconciling others to Christ (2 Cor 5:18, 20). Like Uzziah, you too have a “sphere of influence” which you impact. It includes your family and friends, as well as everyone with whom you interact and those who observe your interaction(s) with others. Your ability to lead within it and influence others for the kingdom of God is directly related to your walk with the Lord and will prosper as you seek and surrender to Him. Will you seek Him? Will you surrender to Him and serve Him in the great cause for which Jesus came and for which He died: reconciling the lost to God that they might worship the Lord in spirit and in truth as He has proscribed?

It is our prayer for you, and for ourselves, that we would do what is right in the eyes of the LORD. . .without exception.

The Lord has kept us busy even though we have stayed in Southern Illinois this month. There were a number of Sundays the Lord had Cindy and I ministering outside our home church as I preached in various churches. As well, we have been sharing the Gospel and praying for the needs of others at the local foodbanks and diving into God’s word at the Lighthouse Shelter. In addition to this, Cindy leads a women’s Bible study. In these things, we are blessed to serve our Lord by encouraging others and expositing His truth when we are home.

Clothing continues to come in for the ministry of Vieux Carre Baptist Church in New Orleans. Thank you for your continued commitment to this facet of our ministry to the Lord.
