“Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure. . .”

2 Peter 1:10 (NKJV)

In the Scripture above, the Apostle Peter encourages us not to take our salvation for granted. Instead, he says *we should be earnestly striving to ensure that our faith is the genuine article*. Verses 5-7 of 2 Peter list a progression of growth that yields fruit consistent with salvation. This should not be considered a list of works to be performed but a progressive change ultimately expressed through the Christ-life we are called to live; a life that cannot truly be mimicked by the lost in their sin-nature. Why? Because such a life is ours through the divine power of God that only comes to us through Jesus and the “exceedingly great and precious promises” of God that are now ours through faith (2 Peter 1:3-4).
